Sharing a Leg — QR & Join Code

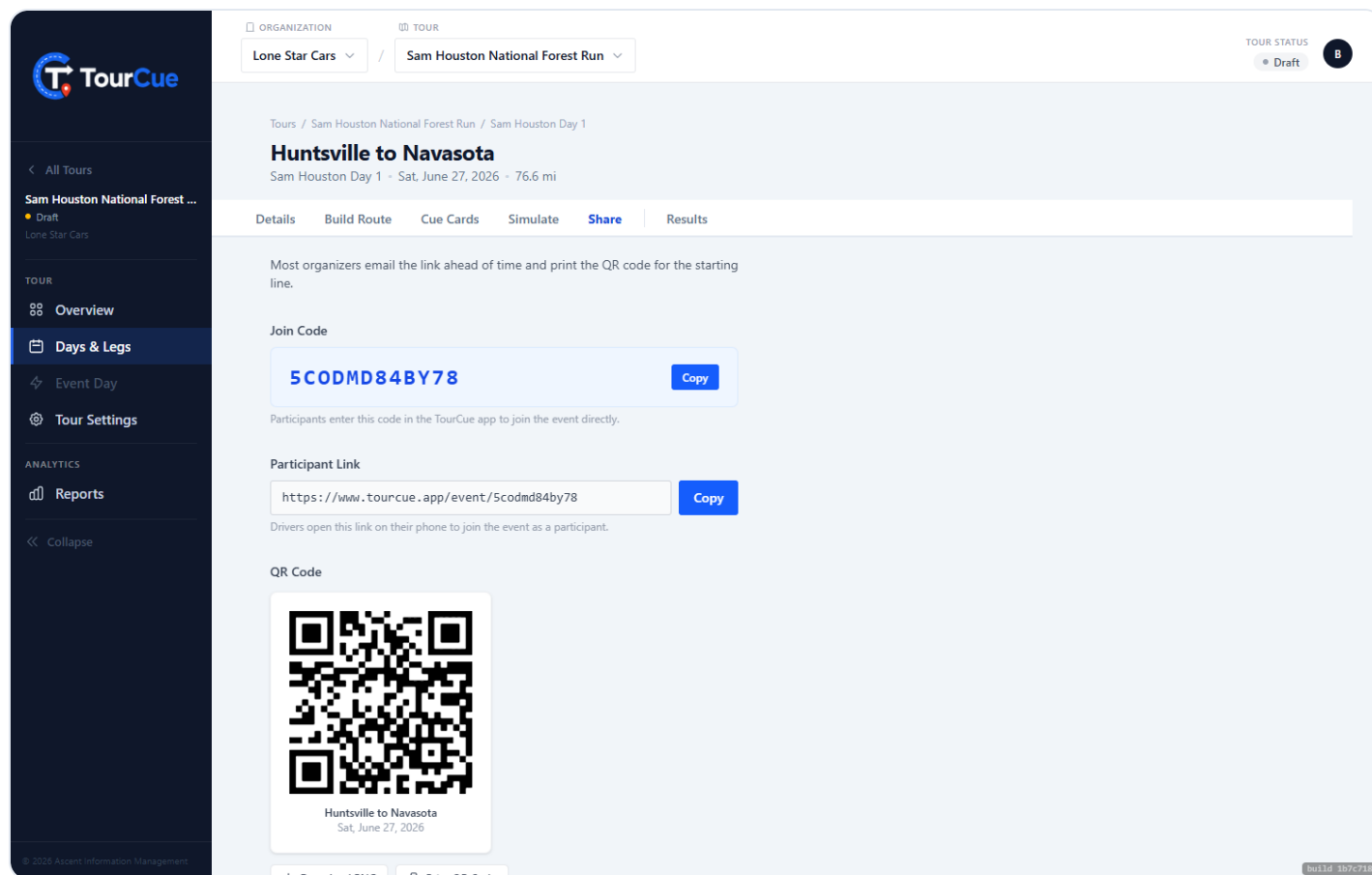
Every leg has its own Share panel — four ways to get the route into your drivers' hands.

1 Join code & participant link

A 12-character join code drivers type into the TourCue app, and a participant link that opens the app on tap — perfect for the group chat or an event-morning text.

2 QR code

Download or print the QR. Tape it to the sign-in table or show it at the drivers' meeting — scan, and the app opens with the route loaded. Zero training required.

3 Lead car passcode

Share this one only with your lead driver. It's required to claim the Lead Car role, which can drop caution pins that every driver sees.
